Main Termly Focus	DT: Structures: Constructing windmills Designing, decorating and building a windmill for their mouse client to live in, developing an understanding of different types of windmill, how they work and their key features.	Art: Drawing: Make your mark Developing observational drawing skills when exploring mark-making. Children use a range of tools, investigating how texture can be created in drawings. They apply their skills to a collaborative piece using music as a stimulus and investigate artists Bridget Riley and Zaria Forman.	DT: Textiles: Puppets Exploring different ways of joining fabrics before creating their own hand puppets based upon characters from a well- known fairytale. Children work to develop their technical skills of cutting, gluing, stapling and pinning.	Art: Sculpture and 3D: Paper play Creating simple three dimensional shapes and structures using familiar materials, children develop skills in manipulating paper and card. They fold, roll and scrunch materials to make their own sculpture. There are opportunities to extend learning to make a collaborative sculptural piece based on the art of Louise Bourgeois.	DT: Cooking and nutrition: Smoothies Handle and explore fruits and vegetables and learn how to identify fruit, before undertaking taste testing to establish chosen ingredients for a smoothie they will make, with accompanying packaging.	Art: Painting and mixed media: Colour splash Exploring colour mixing through paint play, children use a range of tools and work on different surfaces. They create paintings inspired by Clarice Cliff and Jasper Johns.
