

Sendia Update December 2024

Rationale

Our rationale for applying for the SEND Inclusion Award is to acknowledge the work Clowne Infant and Nursery School already do to ensure inclusivity for all, to ensure high quality support for children with additional needs and to improve professional development for staff.

Progress so far....

- We have created a working group comprising of students, parents, staff and governors. The working group initially completed a self-evaluation which then informed a detailed action plan to share with stakeholders.
- Following an initial visit from our advisor on 22nd November 2024, positive feedback was received, and a plan was put in place with the Working Group to begin uploading evidence to be checked.
- The final verification will take place in on 1st April 2025 when a verifier will examine paper work, talk to governors, staff, parents and pupils and meet with Mrs Kirby and Mrs Barnett.
